ILS PRIVACY NOTICE – PROCESSING PERSONAL DATA FOR LIFESAVING SPORT EVENTS

1. ABOUT THE ILS AND LIFESAVING SPORT

The International Life Saving Federation (ILS) sponsors athletic competition as an important method of furthering its humanitarian lifesaving work. Lifesaving through competition is one of its established goals. The motto of the ILS is “be fit to save a life”. The ILS is the International Governing Body for Lifesaving Sport. It also encourages its national lifesaving member federations to take the same approach in supporting lifesaving sport events.

The ILS processes personal data as needed to be able to manage its lifesaving sports events. The systems used are OrgaNet and RescueSoft. Some national federations may use the same systems as the ILS for the same purpose.

To comply with the General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR under EU Directive 2016/679), and to manage the administration of its events, the ILS collects, stores and processes personal data to ensure that all participants are:

- confirmed as eligible to take part in the appropriate events
- entered into the correct events
- provided with an appropriate security accreditation to participate
- kept informed and provided with the necessary communications about the event that they are travelling to attend
- able to view the results of the competitions in which they participate

The ILS has a legitimate interest to process this personal data and retain it for as long as is required as set out in the table below:

2. PERSONAL DATA PROCESSED BY THE ILS FOR LIFESAVING SPORT EVENTS

Lifesaving Sport event registration (including competitors, team managers, team officials, technical officials)	Event Administration	Legitimate interests (Some processing may be with the consent of the individuals where data is transferred outside of the EU)	A minimum of two years from the date of the previous event, unless there are associated financial transaction records which should be kept as long as is required (up to 6 years)

Type of data	Purpose	Legal Basis	Retention Period
Lifesaving Sport event results records	Event Administration	Legitimate interests	Indefinitely – the records stay forever as a historical record of the results of all previous appropriate Lifesaving Sport events
ILS World Records	Event Administration	Legitimate interests	Indefinitely – as an historical record of the creation of new world records – two lists are maintained, the current records, and the historical list showing all records as they are established

3. DATA SHARING

The ILS shares some of the personal data collected with the following organisations:

Organisation	Purpose of the Sharing
Host of the Lifesaving Sport event	To enable the ILS and host organisation to successfully deliver the Lifesaving Sport event
National Lifesaving Federations	To enable the ILS to verify that event attendees of that member federation are eligible to participate in the Lifesaving Sport event

The ILS will not share personal data with other organisations for any other purpose than that for which the data was collected:

- to verify eligibility to participate
- to provide appropriate security accreditation to participate
- to communicate with and to inform about the activities of the organisation
- to manage the administration of its events.

The ILS also requires those organisations with which it shares personal data to ensure that they process the data shared strictly in accordance with the appropriate data protection regulations, and not to use the data for any other purpose than that for which it has been collected and shared

4. USING OTHER ORGANISATIONS TO PROCESS DATA

The ILS is the Data Controller for all personal data that it gathers. While the ILS does process some of this data itself, it uses certain organisations to process some of the data via specific software licences on its behalf. Through this approach it ensures that all data is processed accurately and securely and in compliance with the General Data Protection Regulations.

Delta IT	To enable the processing of personal data, via the OrgaNet software in connection with the management of the Lifesaving Sport Event
DLRG	To enable the processing of personal data, via RescueSoft software in connection with the management of the Lifesaving Sport Event
Combell	To enable the processing of personal data on the ILS Website in connection with the Administration and Event Administration of the ILS

5. INTERNATIONAL TRANSFERS

Personal data collected through the OrgaNet software system that is required to administrate the Lifesaving Sport Event is not normally transferred outside the EU, except when the Lifesaving Sport Event is hosted in a country outside the EU. Other events for national lifesaving federations may also be administrated through the OrgaNet system, but the personal data collected for these events will not be transferred outside the EU

unless the event is held outside the EU. The RescueSoft system is used to manage the Lifesaving Sport Event and publish the results of the competitions. The transfer of data from OrgaNet to RescueSoft normally happens in the EU

Host of the Lifesaving Sport event if outside the EU	To enable the ILS and host organisation to successfully deliver the Lifesaving Sport Event	Where the host country is outside the EU, the ILS has ensured that the host will: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> store all personal data transferred securely in accordance with the appropriate data protection regulations only use the data for the purpose for which it has been collected and transferred The details of the host organisation for each Lifesaving Sport event are shown on the ILS Website: https://www.ilsf.org/lifesaving-sport/lwc
National Lifesaving Federations	To enable the ILS to verify that event attendees of that member federation are eligible to participate in the Lifesaving Sport events	Some federations are in the EU, the majority are outside the EU – however, the data transferred to each federation only concerns the members of that federation who are normally citizens of that country. Each federation is required to store all personal data transferred securely in accordance with the appropriate data protection regulations, and not use the data for any other purpose for which it has been collected and transferred.

It is necessary for the ILS, in order to effectively manage its events, to transfer appropriate personal data to the host organisation to enable it to successfully deliver its performance obligations under the hosting contract it has concluded with the ILS.

The transfer of personal data in these circumstances is in the interests of all the participants to ensure that they are correctly registered to participate in the event, are eligible to participate and can receive the necessary information specific to the particular event.

When appropriate, including when the data is transferred outside the EU, the ILS seeks the consent of those whose personal data is collected to ensure that the transfer of their personal data complies with the relevant Articles of the GDPR. This consent may be withdrawn at the request of the individual at any time.

6. SECURE STORAGE OF DATA

All personal data held within the ILS is stored in a secure environment that meets the appropriate data protection regulations

7. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the following rights concerning your personal data

Right	What this means
Right of access	You have the right to obtain confirmation from the ILS as to whether or not personal data concerning you are being processed, and where that is the case, access to that personal data
Right to rectification	You have the right to oblige the ILS to rectify inaccurate personal data concerning you. Taking into account the circumstances of the processing,

Right	What this means
	you have the right to have incomplete personal data completed by providing a supplementary statement
Right to erasure (right to be forgotten)	You have the right (under certain circumstances, but not all) to oblige the ILS to erase personal data concerning you – where erasure is not possible, it may be possible in some circumstances to anonymise your data, but this will depend on the circumstances of the processing
Right to restriction of processing	You have the right (under certain circumstances, but not all) to oblige the ILS to restrict processing of your personal data. For example, you may request this if you are contesting the accuracy of the personal data held about you
Right to data portability	You have the right (under certain circumstances, but not all) to oblige the ILS to provide you with the personal data about you which you have provided to the ILS in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format. You also have the right to oblige the ILS to transmit those data to another data controller
Right to withdraw consent	If the lawful basis for processing is consent, you have the right to withdraw that consent which you can exercise where appropriate
Right to object	Where your personal data are processed for direct marketing purposes, you have the right to object at any time to processing of your personal data for this purpose. Where your personal data are processed for other purposes, if the ILS, as the data controller, has a compelling legitimate interest to continue processing the data, it may not be possible to uphold that objection
Rights in relation to automated decision making and profiling	The ILS does not perform any automated decision-making based on personal data that produces legal effects or similarly significantly affects you
